THIS FORM MUST ACCOMPANY THE CROWBOROUGH TOWN COUNCIL 'APPLICATION FOR INTERMENT' FORM.

All new purchasers of an Exclusive Right of Burial need to read and accept the Crowborough Town Council Cemetery Regulations — these will be distributed by your Funeral Director at the time of purchase. If you have not received a copy of the Cemetery Regulations please DO NOT sign this form. By signing this form you are agreeing to abide by all of the Cemetery Regulations.

For your information a **<u>summary</u>** of **<u>some of the key points</u>** can be found below:

- No interment shall take place and no memorial shall be placed in the cemetery nor shall any
 additional inscription be made on memorials without the prior consent of the Council and the signed
 agreement of all the owners of the EROB.
- Before any memorials may be erected or works undertaken to an existing memorial, an application must be submitted to the Council for approval and any fees paid accordingly.
- No work should be undertaken until a permit has been issued.
- All installations must be constructed and installed with the current National Association of Memorial Masons (NAMM) or British Register of Accredited Memorial Masons (BRAMM) recommendations.
- Anyone who erects a memorial or who undertakes any memorial work within the cemetery, not in compliance with these Regulations, may be compelled to remove it.
- The placing on graves of glass containers or shades, items of pottery, tins, plastic or wire mesh fences or other items of metal, plastic or other material are forbidden and may be removed by the Council without notice.
- The planting of shrubs and trees within the grave space is not permitted and may be removed by the Council.
