At the meeting of the Planning and Development Committee on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> July 2020 it was resolved to use funds from the visioning budget to obtain specialist legal advice as to a possible course of action

in respect of the WDC decision on planning application: WD/2017/2197/MAO

On the 27<sup>th</sup> February 2020, the committee made the following resolution:

As a result of the committee's decision it was agreed that the £10,000 currently in earmarked reserves for a visioning document should be transferred to General Reserves as per the RFO's financial report for the planning meeting of the 27<sup>th</sup> January.

**8998**      **RESOLVED** to transfer the Committee's £10,000 Earmarked Reserve back to the General Reserves.

The resolution made on the 27<sup>th</sup> July is therefore invalid as the committee does not have the funds to follow through this course of action.

In order to release funds from the General Reserves the committee must obtain approval from Full Council.
