Background:

The grounds team use a Trimax Pegasus trailed rotary mower with a tractor to cut the large open areas such as football pitches and recreation grounds. This mower had a fault on the 21st June 2021 whereby the blades became loose and could not be tightened any further. Due to the safety concern the machine had to be put out of action and the new parts were immediately ordered. There has been a significant delay on receiving the new parts as we were first advised 2-3 days, we are still at this time waiting for the parts to arrive.

This has meant that the grounds team only alternative to cut the grass is to use the John Deere ride on mower. They originally had two ride on machines, however one broke down and was due to be sold as agreed by the committee previously. This machine has since been used as a spares machine for the second ride on mower the grounds team have, which has saved on various expensive parts to date. The second ride on mower has been serviced annually by Burden Bros Agri and was last serviced on the 30/03/21 where it had to have £2241.50 spent on it due to parts becoming worn. This second ride on mower has now broken down. It has had to be recovered back to Wolfe yard on a trailer and struggles to start along with emitting clouds of white smoke when it does start up briefly. It cannot be used in its current condition. A mechanic is due to assess it on Friday 9th July 2021 to establish if it is beyond repair. It is unknown what the cost would be if it can be repaired.

The Environment committee have agreed to purchase a new ride on collecting mower for use at Heatherview which would also have been able to be used across other sites in Crowborough in this situation. However, there is currently a huge delay on being able to obtain new machines and spare parts which is causing this new machine to be delayed in being delivered for 2-3 months.

Current Position:

The grounds team currently do not have any working machine capable of cutting grass beyond the capabilities of a strimmer. The weather we are experiencing is perfect for grass growing and the football pitches that have been fertilised are growing at an increased rate and at risk of being damaged if not cut regularly.

Rental/ Contracting:

A machine capable of being used as a ride on can be hired at a rate of £885.00 per week. This machine however cannot be driven on the road and so would have to be used with a trailer. The trailer we have would be able to hold the machine but not the cutting deck. We also only have one full time member of staff on the grounds team who can tow a trailer of this size.

For the football pitches we have previously contracted out to a company to cut our pitches once. This cost the Council £800.00 for one cut of all pitches and recreation grounds. At this time of year this cut would have to be carried out weekly until the Trimax is working again.

Therefore, the rental/ contracting option will cost £1685.00 per week until the machines are fixed. It is unknown at this time how long that could be.

Purchasing a new machine:

The Council could purchase a new ride on machine whilst the cost of repairing the old one is established. It is likely that the old one would need replacing soon anyway as it is getting to the end of its economic life, and this would ensure that the grounds team have a fully working machine. If the old machine is still able to be fixed at a cost-effective amount, then it could be kept as a spare machine until it no longer becomes financially worth keeping.

Due to the long delays in purchasing a new machine from suppliers' machines have had to be sought based on not only their practical ability to do the work required by the grounds team, but also on their current stock availability. All quotes provided below are from suppliers who have the machine in stock. Quotes 1 and 2 would be collected, quote 3 includes delivery.

The machine will have to be made road legal to transport it between sites and therefore there may be a delay of around 10-14 days from placing the order to being able to use it on the roads. As an interim fix the member of grounds team that can use the trailer would be able to transport it between sites where needed on a short-term basis. This would not however delay the purchase of the machine.

There are sufficient funds in the 4039/301 Capital Purchases budget to cover the purchase of this machine.


