Income

1011/305 Fireworks – Due to the event being cancelled income will not reach budget 1012/305 Summer Fair – Income has exceeded budget due to the larger event this year. This offsets an overspend on the expenses code 4203/305 where costs include last minute expenditure due to the heatwave forecast

1013/305 Sussex Day – Income has exceeded budget due to the larger event held this year to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee.

Expenses

4203/305 – as mentioned above expenses increased due to the unusual weather experienced during the weekend

4217/305 Special Events — expenditure relates to event planned Summer 2023 and this money will be journalled out at the end of the year so that it shows in the figures for 2023/24

4255/305 Equipment – This has exceeded budget due to a telephone contract being taken out part way through the year
