Crowborough Rotary Club has contacted the council with regard to the Rotary District End Polio Now campaign.

In order to raise awareness of the campaign Rotary Clubs in the region have been asked to plant crocus bulbs. Crowborough Rotary would like to support the End Polio Now campaign by purchasing 4000 bulbs and have asked if the council have a planting area that would be suitable. The area must also have a plaque stating the reason for the planting.

Crowborough Rotary Club has deadline of the 5th August by which it must place the order for the bulbs. The club has offered to plant the bulbs in the Autumn.

The area required would need to be 40 square metres and would need to be uncut. The cost to purchase 4000 crocus bulbs would be in the region of £350.00.
